

Prawn Fishing Competition



Thank you for entering our competition and good luck

General rules:

1. Huka Prawn Park is open from 9am until 4pm each day of the school holidays
2. Competition entry is free once you've paid your admission fee
3. You can spend as much time as you want each day fishing, from 9am until 4pm, however the final measure-in time is 3.30pm each day. Any prawns caught after that time will not be counted.
4. Huka Prawn Park staff will measure and record any prawns you want to enter into the competition, this will be done at the fishing huts beside the fishing ponds
5. All prawns must be caught using equipment supplied by Huka Prawn Park.
6. Huka Prawn Park reserves the right to disallow any prawn for entry into the competition.
7. Your name, telephone number and email will be recorded at the measuring
8. A condition of entry is that Huka Prawn Park may include names and photos of the winners in publicity material including our Facebook page, Instagram and Twitter
9. The judges (Huka Prawn Park staff) decision is final

Longest Prawn competition

10. A notice showing the longest prawn caught each day will be on display throughout the day at our fishing park hut area
11. The prawns are measured from the tip of their tail to the end of their outstretched pincer by Huka Prawn Park Staff.
12. The daily winners will be announced each day at 3.40pm in our reception foyer area
13. The daily prizes for the longest prawn will be:
 - Either \$100.00 voucher for a family meal in our restaurant at Huka Prawn Park or 1 Huka Jet Ride
14. The grand prize will be given to the person who caught the longest prawn throughout the two-week period, the winner will be notified and will receive:
 - \$300.00 cash prize and a \$200.00 voucher for our Riverside Restaurant at Huka Prawn Park (valid for 12 months)

Family Division: Most prawns caught

15. To enter you need to complete an entry form and take it, along with your prawns to the Huka Prawn Park Staff in either fishing hut.
16. To enter into the family division, your team must consist of:
 - At least one adult and one child (under 15 years old).
 - Immediate family only, this includes grandparents, parents and children but excludes aunts, uncles and cousins.
 - A maximum number 2 adults and 5 children.
17. One grand prize will be given to the family who caught the most prawns in any given day that the competition is running. There are no daily prizes available. The family will receive:
 - An annual family pass for unlimited admission into Huka Prawn Park (valid for 12 months) which can only be used by those in the team which won the competition.
